This position will manage the operation and safety standards of a regional water park. Required certifications are lifeguard, standard First Aid and Basic Life Support or equivalent, Water Safety Instructor and Pool Operator. Instructor ratings in Life-guarding, First Aid and CPR are preferred. Certifications must be from Ellis associates or American Red Cross. Troubleshooting and preventive maintenance skills desirable.
