- 2. Copy of an official transcript showing that the applicant is currently enrolled in a park, recreation, natural resource, therapeutic recreation or related curriculum and must carry a minimum of 12 credits at the time of the application.
- 3. Letter of recommendation from a faculty member.
- 4. Letter of recommendation from a park and recreation professional.
- 5. You <u>MUS</u>T register and pay for the conference registration fee prior to being approved for a conference scholarship! As long as you meet all criteria, you will be reimbursed by the WPRA Foundation immediately after the conference as long as you attend everything that you were registered for.
