

WPRA Aquatic Section Board Member Responsibilities

COMMERCIAL ADVISORY REPRESENTATIVE

TERM: Two years. A commercial member may only serve a two year term. If after the two year term the Section cannot fill this advisory board position, it must remain vacant until a special appointment or election can take place. No consecutive terms by the same commercial member will be allowed.

STRUCTURE: One commercial member may serve on a WPRA Section Board in an advisory capacity with no voting rights. This position does not count toward a meeting quorum. Representative must be a current commercial member of WPRA

PURPOSE: Represent WPRA commercial members on the Section Board, and provide insight and recommendations that are pertinent to the Section's business.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Serve as liaison for WPRA commercial members on the Section Board. Keep the Section Board informed of issues and concerns relating to commercial members.
2. Serve on Section committees and or task forces as needed.

Section Rules of Order:

Section Advisory Representatives shall be a current WPRA commercial member, and shall be elected by the total membership of the WPRA Section. This is a two year term, and a member may not serve two consecutive terms.

This shall be an advisory position with no voting rights, nor will this position count toward the Section Board's quorum for meetings.
